




Academic Title / Diploma

The Undergraduate Studies Program entitled "Creative Writing, Arts, and Humanities" offers the theoretical and practical background and skills in relevant professional and research fields from the world of books, editing and publishing production as well as cultural production and industry in general. The newly offered program in the English language starts from the academic year 2024-2025.

The Bachelor's degree is awarded by the Department of Early Childhood Education of the School of Social Sciences and Humanities of the University of Western Macedonia, in collaboration with the Department of Business Administration of the School of Economics which coorganizes the program.





Scope of the program

To educate at undergraduate level non-Greek citizens in Greece in creative writing and literary studies and to promote research in the field of Creative Writing including:

- the active apperception of literary genres
- the training of graduates in modern theories and methods of analysis production of literary and other related texts (scripts, fairy tales, songs, etc.)
- the promotion of interdisciplinary research both at academic and research levels in matters of literature film and television writing as well as in a broader scale of cultural production and industry.





Purpose of the program

- high-level undergraduate studies and the preparation of high-level related diploma theses
- the opportunity for integrated studies in the field of Creative Writing in the direction of research or personal writing, academic and literary as well, as specialized in the field of cinematography and television writing.

Visa

Students enrolled will receive a certificate for their registration to present to the Greek consular authorities of their country to obtain an entry and residence permit for studies (Schengen visa) with a duration of 4.5 years including 6 months of optional placement.

Study Program – *Credits*

- The curriculum of the 4-year/8-semester program is designed taking into account the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS).
- One semester corresponds to 30 ECTS and 13 full weeks of teaching.
- 240 ECTS are needed for graduation.
- For those who have attended international education programs as exchange students the time of the program, the credits and the corresponding score are recognized as actual study time.


